Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to be able to confirm that the Year 6 residential to Brecon Beacons will be taking place during the next academic year from Monday 16th September to Friday 20th September 2024.

The Year 6 team will be holding an information evening for parents on Thursday 18th January 2024 at 3.30pm in school.

The trip enhances your child's Geography curriculum at Nightingale. At Brecon, your child will have the opportunity to explore the significant human and physical features of their surroundings whilst being involved in field work activities. This fantastic residential also encourages children to become more independent, take on responsibilities and work as a team. It is a brilliant experience where they take part in many activities, such as caving, canoeing and mountain walking.
