In Science, your child will know that:

Darwin as a young man travelled around the world on the HMS Beagle. On this 5-year voyage he saw lots of things and recorded down lots of evidence which allowed him to work out how organisms change over time by a different mechanism of

Natural selection.

In <u>Design Technology</u>, your child will:

Design and create a textile puppet of a rainforest animal for sale at the living rainforest gift shop.

They will evaluate existing products and decide on the age range their puppet will be designed for. Then they will need to explore the required stitching needed to create appropriate joins of their materials. Further to this, they will then design and make their own puppet using all skill they have developed. At the end of the journey, they will compare their work back to the existing products and evaluate their final

outcomes.

In Geography, your child will know that:

Location and position of country to the equator/
