Visit to Hillier Gardens Arboretum - Year 1

Dear Parents

To kick start the first topic of the summer term - 'Adventures Outside, we have organised an exciting trip to Hillier Gardens Arboretum near Romsey. This will take place on Tuesday 16th April. The children will be involved in some fantastic "hands on" experiences hopefully including;

- Pond dipping
- Habitat investigation
- Mini beast treasure hunts
- Learning about the lifecycles



Children will also have the opportunity to tour the beautiful grounds and participate in other activities. It will be a truly wonderful experience for them.

The coach will leave school at 9.15am and return in time for the end of the day. The whole day at Hillier's is spent outdoors. Hopefully, by April we will be having some warmer drier weather, but due to the increased risk of ticks, children will need both their arms & legs covered so therefore we suggest a school polo shirt and jumper with trousers or leggings. We will confirm nearer the time exactly what is required.

Children will need a packed lunch, including a non-fizzy drink. You can pre-order a school meal from HC3S on the Google form below. A fruit snack will be provided.



We would also love some parent helpers. For safeguarding reasons, all volunteers need to have DBS check through the school. If you would like to help on trips, and do not have a DBS check, please visit our [website](#) for more information. Due to the popularity of these trips, the class teacher will contact you to confirm if you are needed.

The cost of this fabulous trip is £20.00 per child. We believe this experience will be very beneficial to the children's learning. To ensure that these trips can go ahead it is imperative that a contribution is received for every child. The school is not in a position to subsidise pupil visits, as this impacts negatively on other areas of the school budget.

We are requesting that full payment is received prior to the trip taking place and to facilitate this, we have broken your contribution down into three manageable instalments.
