

If we choose not to follow the rules or to act in ways that are against our school values, the adults will help us to understand:

- What happened
- What we were thinking and feeling
- How this has impacted on others
- What we should try to do next time
- How we can make things right again.

This could include:

- Apologising
- Clearing up any mess we have made
- Possibly missing some play time.



For more serious behaviour, for example if we are being unsafe or making it impossible for others to learn, we might have to leave the classroom. We may also have to miss our lunchtime play or have a loss of privileges, such as Eagle duties. Our parents will be told should this happen.

Bullying, fighting, stealing, swearing and damaging property are all unacceptable. If we choose to behave this way, a number of things might happen;

- A letter may get sent home
- Our parents might have to come into school to discuss our behaviour
- We may get sent home. This is called "suspended" and is very serious

Even if this behaviour happens outside of school, for example when we are walking home or online, it is still unacceptable and we may still be suspended.

- Getting our name on the recognition board
- Notes/postcards home

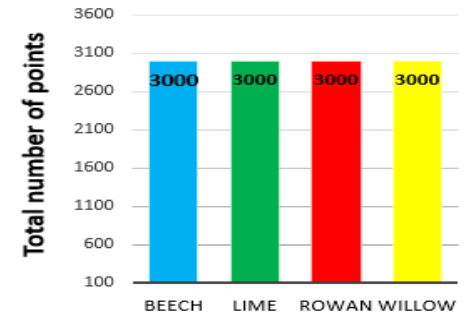


Every adult and child at Nightingale belongs to 1 of our 4 houses; Beech, Lime, Rowan or Willow.

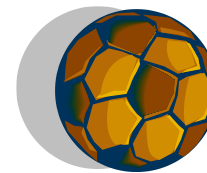
Every Dojo point we earn, is also a point for our house. We can earn extra points for our houses by having Green Band Attendance and for walking into school sensibly after break and lunchtime.



In Celebration Assembly each week, we find out which house has the best school attendance and which house has the most Dojo points.
