Year 3 - Sea City Museum Friday 26 April 2024

Dear Parents

To support the first topic of the Summer term - The Titanic, we have planned a fantastic trip to the Sea City Museum in Southampton which will take place on **Friday 26th April 2024**.

The children will take part in a workshop learning about life on board the Titanic and visiting the museums special exhibition about the Titanic Story. There will also be time to view the exhibit; Titanic: The Legend.

We will be travelling by coach and children will need to be in full school uniform. They will need to wear sensible shoes or black trainers, along with a waterproof coat. The coach will leave school at 9.30am and return in time for the end of the day.

Children will need a packed lunch, including a non-fizzy drink. You can pre-order a school meal and your child will be provided with a packed lunch from school.

We would also love some parent helpers. For safeguarding reasons, all volunteers need to have a DBS check through the school. If you would like to help on trips, and do not have a DBS check, please visit our [website](#) for more information. Due to the popularity of these trips, it will be first come first served so let the class teacher as soon as possible and the class teacher will contact you to confirm if you are needed.

The cost of this fabulous trip is **£15.50 per child**. We are asking that every pupil contributes as we believe this event will be very beneficial to each child's learning. If we do not receive enough contributions, however, then the trip may not be able to go ahead.

We are requesting that full payment is received prior to the trip taking place and to facilitate this, we have broken your contribution down to three instalments:

However, if you do not wish to pay via Scopay, we are happy to accept cash or a cheque in a sealed envelope, clearly labelled with your child's name and class.

As well as medical consent and lunch choice, this form can also be used to indicate your interest in being a parent helper.
